

Solberg Airport, Readington Township, NJ



GTS Consultants provided topographic and boundary survey support for the extension of the existing runway at Solberg – Hunterdon Airport, Readington Township, Hunterdon County, New Jersey. Topographic mapping covered approximately 80 acres of the 102-acre airport and was performed using a combination of GPS-RTK technology and conventional ground data collection. In addition, GTS located existing boundary markers for the Airport property and developed NJ State Plane coordinate values for the survey mapping. Solberg Airport is home to the New Jersey Festival of Ballooning each summer since



1985 and has grown to 175,000 in attendance.

Solberg Airport is the subject of current eminent domain litigation between the landowner and the municipality for the 625 acres of land surrounding the airport. In January 2010, The State Supreme Court denied the Township's appeal of the Appellate Court's decision in favor of the land owners. A Superior Court Trial will follow.

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
